ROCK & ROLL POSTER ART SHOW



ARLO GUTHRIE is coming to Reno on March 18th as a part of his 40th Anniversary tour.

Celebrate ROCK & ROLL & BLUES ART with Marshall and Paige Stevenson at the Wildflower Penultimate Saturday opening on March 18th from Noon to Six pm. Rock & Roll Classics will be played, Wine, Shrimp and Hors D'oeuvres will be served. A perfect way to spend the afternoon and then enjoy the ARTOWN ARLO GUTHRIE CONCERT to be held later that evening at the new Summit Sierra Shopping Center.

Wildflower will feature more than 125 Rock & Roll posters from the collection of Marshall Stevenson. Marshall, a former nightclub manager for notables such as Dick Clark, Paul Revere of Paul Revere and The Raiders, and Bill Medley of The Righteous Brothers, he was also a partner and operating manager of Dick Clark's "American Bandstand" Club, and Paul Revere's "Kicks" in Reno as well as The Righteous Brothers' "Hop" in Fountain Valley California. While working for Dick Clark in his many "American Bandstand" Restaurants and nightclubs across the nation, Marshall collected many vintage rock and blues pieces, most of which are limited productions, or original pieces. Some also graced the walls of "American Bandstand" in Miami, and in Reno. Typical works KISS, The BEATLES, GRATEFUL DEAD, LED ZEPPELIN, as well as many of the early BILL GRAHAM PRESENTS poster art pieces.

All of these pieces will be offered at The Open Door Gallery at 4335 West 4th Street, and Chapel Gallery at 4305 West 4th Street from March 1st through March 31st daily, from Noon to Six pm.
